Conference Description

The **North Carolina Employment & Training Association's Annual Spring Conference** is a two and one-half day annual event. Conference Committee members will evaluate all proposals based on the information submitted by **February 28, 2023.** Presenters, titles and content are expected to correspond to the proposal and substitutions of content or presenters require approval by Conference Co-Chairs. Once a workshop has been accepted, no changes of presenters or workshop content will be allowed without prior approval.

Presenters will be notified no later than March 15, 2023 if their workshop(s) have been accepted.
